## SUMMER PROGRAMME

Over the summer holiday, I will be running various sessions during August. You will find a detailed outline of each on the final page:

1. 10+ preparation
2. Secondary Ready Maths

## 10+ PREPARATION

Kingston Grammar School and Hampton School both offer 10+ Advance Place examinations. These are timetabled for 6th January 2018 (KGS) and 4th November 2017 (Hampton School) for Year 5 children. I am offering introductory 10+ preparation lessons, focusing on writing and comprehension skills, in addition to key maths concepts and problem solving. Please contact me for further information.



## WEBINAR

Earlier this year, I piloted a series of maths lessons for parents to teach some of the methods children are taught in primary school. I am excited to say that I plan to run a series of webinars (web-based seminars) to reach a wider audience and hope to be offering these soon, so look out for an email regarding this. I will be emailing those parents who were on the initial pilot about trialling this webinar at the end of June. We will let you know how we get on.



## SECONDARY READY MATHS

This is a maths refresher to prepare children for their transition to secondary school. Within the first week or so of the new term, children are assessed in maths, the result determining which ability group they are set in. An inevitable “summer learning loss” is experienced by children over the extended holiday, meaning that children are unprepared for this initial test. It is not uncommon for children to find themselves in a lower set than is appropriate to their ability and this can lead to unnecessary frustration and anxiety.

A short, sharp boost of maths prior to the start of term can help your child make a positive start to their new school and help them prepare mentally for the new journey ahead.

## BOOSTER 1:1 SESSIONS

These individual sessions will provide your child with a bespoke learning experience in which they can address any areas of English and/or maths where they lack confidence or need support. The classroom can be the most daunting place for a child when they haven't grasped a concept. Worried about what their peers might think or too shy to ask the teacher for help, gaps in learning can easily occur. Often children are taught a new concept, for which they are simply not ready. Having a 1:1 experience offers your child the freedom to ask the questions they daren't ask in class and the opportunity to explore concepts that have historically seemed too challenging.

## CREATIVE WRITING WORKSHOP FOR 7-11 YEAR OLDS

Children love to write for fun. What better way to spend a couple of hours on a summer's day doing just that. No holds barred, your child will be given a writing stimulus, to respond to, expressing their ideas in any way they choose: poetry, prose, narrative, comic strip etc. More information about this to follow. ## SHAPE OF 11+ PROVISION

Some of you have been asking what the shape of 11+ provision is going to look like in the run up to the 11+ exams. I will be sending parents of 11+ tutees an overview of what the children will be covering in the next half term and what homework to expect. I am also in the process of compiling a guided summer programme for these children and will be offering this as a means of tuition to ensure that they remain on track in their preparation for their exams. More news of this to follow. It is crucial that these children continue with their learning over the summer holidays as it is well documented that this long break results in what is known as 'summer learning loss'.


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
